

Call for Participation in the

Pilot course Transversal Skills in Applied Artificial Intelligence (TSAAI)

Rijeka, 1. August 2024

As a part of the project Transversal Skills in Applied Artificial Intelligence (TSAAI), Erasmus+ 2021-1-ES01-KA220-HED-000030125 (2022-2025), a pilot course is organised for the interested students.

The pilot course has a total duration of three months and begins on September 30. 2024. The first two weeks, i.e. from 30. September to 11. October 2024 is held in person at the University of Malaga, in Malaga, Spain, and the rest of the course will be delivered online. The funding provided for the project is for a total of five UNIRI students. The total number of days financed are 10 days of activity plus two days of travel - in total there are 12 days of financing. Each elected student participant will receive a travel support of 530 EUR, and as individual support, each student will receive 58 EUR a day which makes 696 EUR. The support will be delivered observing the national legislation and other applicable rules.

Eligible candidates must be currently enrolled in a university master or a university PhD programme at the University of Rijeka. Other restrictive rules may be applicable to conform to the Erasmus+ framework regulations.

Eligible candidates will be ranked based on their current academic merit, including the following criteria:

- Academic grades in the previously completed programme
- Publications
- Competitions and awards
- Extracurricular activities

Selected candidates take on the responsibility to complete the entire course; otherwise, they will have to remand the entire amount of allocated support funds.

The application should consist of the following documents (in either English or Croatian language), merged into a single .pdf file:

1. Motivation letter (no more than 400 words)
2. CV in Europass format

3. Proof of current enrolment (year 2023/2024) in any UNIRI master or PhD programme
4. Proof of a previously completed programme (university bachelor or higher)
5. Proof of academic grades
6. Proof of other academic merit

Untimely or incomplete applications will not be considered.
